Emergency Resurfacing Work on Oregon Avenue beginning December 17, 2019

(Washington, DC) — The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will conduct roadway resurfacing, milling and paving from **Tuesday, December 17, 2019 to Saturday, December 21, 2019** and construction work hours will be from **8:00 am to 4:00 pm. daily**, weather permitting, to perform construction activities along Oregon Avenue NW at the following locations:

- Military Road to Mooreland Place
- A segment between Mooreland Place and Northampton Street
- Northampton Street, Horse Stable Road and Oregon Avenue NW intersection

This construction work is a necessary process in preparing for Phase 1-1A of the Oregon Avenue Reconstruction Project.

Traffic controls and signage will be in place to safely guide all motorist through the work zone. Motorists are urged to use caution as they travel in these areas, to anticipate moderate delays, and to be mindful of construction personnel.
