Dear District Resident,

The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) has commenced work on the **Reconstruction of Oregon Avenue NW from Military Road to Western Avenue and Western Avenue NW from Oregon Avenue to 31st St.** Construction officially began on December 16, 2019, and is expected to be completed by December 5, 2021.

Construction activities are expected to take place in the following three phases:

- Phase 1 Oregon Avenue NW from Beech Street NW to Western Avenue NW; Western Avenue NW from Oregon Avenue NW to 31st Street NW [December 2019 – July 2020]
- Phase 2 Oregon Avenue NW from Military Road NW to Rittenhouse Street NW [July 2020 – December 2020]
- Phase 3 Oregon Avenue NW from Rittenhouse Street NW to Beech Street NW [December 2020 – September 2021]

The Contractor is authorized to work between 7:00 am and 7:00 pm, Monday through Friday, and on Saturday with DDOT permission. Note: All work performed during the peak travel periods of 7:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. (southbound) and 3:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. (northbound) must be performed behind a barrier and must not impact traffic. During off-peak hours, construction vehicles will share the travel lane with the public. During this time (9:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.) vehicular traffic will be intermittently rerouted via flaggers and detour signs to guide traffic.

To help deliver the project on-time or ahead of schedule, the Contractor will likely request permission to work on most Saturdays. The website will be updated with a three week lookahead schedule which will identify all planned work.

DDOT will ensure that access to driveways will always be maintained, unless specifically notified in advance. If access to/from your driveway is ever temporarily restricted, please notify a flagger, who will restore your access/egress immediately.

Thank you for your patience and support as we work together to implement safer conditions for pedestrians, motorists and cyclists along the Oregon Avenue corridor.
